RESOLUTION OF THE MOUNTAINS RECREATION AND CONSERVATION  
AUTHORITY ASSIGNING RIGHTS TO THE CITY OF CUDAHY TO APPLY  
TO THE LOS ANGELES COUNTY REGIONAL PARK AND OPEN SPACE  
DISTRICT FOR FIRST SUPERVISORIAL DISTRICT PROPOSITION A  
EXCESS FUNDS TO ACQUIRE APN 6226-027-015,  
2322 CLARA STREET, ALONG THE  
LOS ANGELES RIVER,  
CITY OF CUDAHY

*Resolved*, That the Governing Board of the Mountains Recreation and Conservation Authority (MRCA) hereby:

1. FINDS that the **acquisition of APN 6226-027-015** will provide significant public recreational benefits; and
2. FINDS that the people of the County of Los Angeles on November 3, 1992, approved Los Angeles County Proposition A, Safe Neighborhood Parks, Gang Prevention, Tree-Planting, Senior and Youth Recreation, Beaches and Wildlife Protection (the 1992 Proposition), and on November 5, 1996 approved Los Angeles County Proposition A, the Safe Neighborhood Parks Act (the 1996 Proposition), (jointly known as the Propositions), which provide funds to the County for the purposes of acquiring and/or developing facilities for public recreational facilities and open space; and
3. FINDS that this action is exempt from the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act; and
4. FINDS that the staff report dated June 2, 2004 further describes the project; and
5. ADOPTS the staff report and recommendation dated June 2, 2004; and
6. ASSIGNS its rights to the City of Cudahy to apply for Proposition A Excess Funds to acquire APN 6226-027-015, 2322 Clara Street, along the Los Angeles River, City of Cudahy; and

7. RECOMMENDS that the City of Cudahy authorize application to the Los Angeles County Regional Park and Open Space District for Proposition A Excess Funds to acquire APN 6226-027-015, 2322 Clara Street, along the Los Angeles River, City of Cudahy; and
8. AUTHORIZES the Executive Officer to do any and all acts necessary to carry out this resolution and any recommendations made by the Governing Board.
