**RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BOARD OF THE MOUNTAINS RECREATION  
AND CONSERVATION AUTHORITY AUTHORIZING ACCEPTANCE OF A  
CONSERVATION EASEMENTS OVER A PORTION OF APN  
4382-006-001 (2850 BENEDICT CANYON DRIVE),  
APPROXIMATELY 0.05-ACRES, FOR WILDLIFE  
MOVEMENT PURPOSES, IN THE MULHOLLAND  
DRIVE SCENIC CORRIDOR, BENEDICT  
CANYON DRIVE, CITY OF  
LOS ANGELES**

*Resolved*, That the Governing Board of the Mountains Recreation and Conservation Authority (MRCA) hereby:

1. FINDS that the proposed conservation easement on APN 4382-006-001 is ecologically significant; and
2. FINDS that this action is exempt from the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act; and
3. ADOPTS the staff report and recommendation dated October 1, 2014; and
4. AUTHORIZES the acceptance of a conservation easement over a portion of APN 4382-006-001 (2850 Benedict Canyon Drive), approximately 0.05-acres, for wildlife corridor purposes, in the Mulholland Drive Scenic Corridor, in Benedict Canyon; and
5. AUTHORIZES the Executive Officer to do any and all acts necessary to carry out this resolution and any recommendations made by the Governing Board.
