Narrative/Project Description: In 2003 the County of Los Angeles offered the sale of 140 parcels totalling 164 acres in the Sylvia Park area of Topanga Canyon, west of Topanga State Park. A small portion of the subject area is located in the Coastal Zone. Initially the County had an agreement to allow the California Department of Parks and Recreation (DPR) to acquire a group of 27 parcels totalling 58 acres that are directly adjacent to Topanga State Park. However, DPR was unable to complete the acquisition. The requested funding would be used to purchase the 58 acres. The proposed acquisition will protect land and water resources and prevent degradation of the Topanga Canyon watershed. The subject properties are located adjacent to developed residential properties and could be accessed via existing roads. Purchase of the properties is needed to prevent their sale or auction. The MRCA requests that the term of agreement begin September 25, 2006 and end no earlier than December 31, 2007.
