**RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BOARD OF THE MOUNTAINS RECREATION
AND CONSERVATION AUTHORITY AUTHORIZING LOS ANGELES CITY FIRE
DEPARTMENT FUEL BREAK MAINTENANCE WORK ON MRCA PARKLAND WITHIN
THE CITY OF LOS ANGELES WEST OF THE 405 FREEWAY,
INCLUDING WEST MANDEVILLE FIRE ROAD AREA**

Resolved, That the Governing Board of the Mountains Recreation and Conservation Authority (MRCA) hereby:

1. FINDS that fuelbreaks on parklands now owned by the MRCA were established by the City of Los Angeles Fire Department in decades past.
2. FINDS that the Los Angeles City Fire Department has requested to maintain and refurbish the fuelbreaks for strategic firefighting preplanning purposes.
3. FINDS that this action is exempt from the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act; and
4. ADOPTS the staff report and recommendation dated April 4, 2007; and
5. AUTHORIZES the Executive Officer to do any and all acts necessary to carry out this resolution and any recommendations made by the Governing Board.
