RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BOARD OF THE MOUNTAINS RECREATION AND CONSERVATION AUTHORITY AUTHORIZING APPLICATION TO WILDLIFE CONSERVATION BOARD FOR FUNDING THE ACQUISITION OF 120-ACRE PROPERTY (APNS 4455-006-032 AND 033) IN COLD CREEK WATERSHED AND FURTHER AUTHORIZING THE ACQUISITION OF THE SUBJECT PARCELS, CALABASAS

Resolved, That the Governing Board of the Mountains Recreation and Conservation Authority hereby:

- 1. FINDS that acquisition of the subject parcels will preserve core habitat in the Santa Monica Mountains and is necessary for their long term protection.
- 2. FINDS that acquisition costs will be paid for by a combination of funding from the Wildlife Conservation Board, County of Los Angeles, City of Calabasas, and private donations.
- 3. FINDS that the proposed action is categorically exempt from the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act.
- 4. ADOPTS the staff report and recommendation dated February 2, 2011.
- 5. AUTHORIZES the application to Wildlife Conservation Board for \$425,000 for the subject acquisition.
- 6. AUTHORIZES acceptance of funding equal to the total purchase price from Wildlife Conservation Board, County of Los Angeles, City of Calabasas, and other sources.
- 7. AUTHORIZES the acquisition of APNs 4455-006-032 and 033.
- 8. AUTHORIZES the granting of any conservation easements over the subject parcels as requested by either Wildlife Conservation Board or Department of Fish and Game.
- 9. AUTHORIZES such budget amendments that may be necessary to implement these actions.
