RE: Malibu Parks Public Access Enhancement - Public Works Plan

Dear Mr. Edmiston and Ms. Collins,

On October 13, 2010, the Coastal Commission unanimously approved the Malibu Parks Public Access Enhancement Public Works Plan (PWP) with suggested modifications.

The Commission's action is based upon the findings contained in the staff report dated September 29, 2010, addendums dated October 11, 2010 and October 12, 2010, and the adopted findings staff report dated January 12, 2011, which is attached. Also attached are the final suggested modifications approved by the Commission for the PWP. Section 13547 of the Commission's Administrative Regulations requires that after certification, the Executive Director of the Commission shall transmit copies of the resolution of certification and any suggested modifications and findings to the governing authority, and any interested person or agencies. Further, the certification shall not be deemed final and effective until all of the following occur:

- (a) The Santa Monica Mountains Conservancy and Mountains Recreation and Conservation Authority each: (1) acknowledge receipt of the Commission's resolution of certification, including any terms or modifications suggested for final certification and (2) accepts and agrees to any such terms and modifications and takes whatever formal action is required to satisfy the terms and modifications.
- (b) The Executive Director of the Commission determines in writing that the Santa Monica Mountains Conservancy and Mountains Recreation and Conservation Authority actions are legally adequate to satisfy any specific requirements set forth in the Commission's certification order.
- (c) The Executive Director reports the determination to the Commission at its next regularly scheduled public meeting and the Commission does not object to the Executive Director's determination. If a majority of the

Commissioners present object to the Executive Director's determination and find that the Santa Monica Mountains Conservancy's and Mountains Recreation and Conservation Authority's action does not conform to the provisions of the Commission's action to certify the PWP, the Commission shall review the Santa Monica Mountains Conservancy and Mountains Recreation and Conservation Authority action and notification procedures pursuant to Articles 9-12 as if it were a resubmittal.
