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Transportation Capital Improvement Program

Fritz established and oversaw the implementation of the City's first Transportation Capital Improvement Program (CIP), with a total value of \$254 million over five years. The CIP included reconstruction of two interchanges, along with numerous road widenings, intersection improvements, streetscape enhancements, and pavement rehabilitation projects.

Elk Grove Roadway Fee Program

Fritz led the engineering effort associated with the original formation of the Elk Grove Roadway Fee Program (EGRFP) in 2003. The development of this program consolidated five different plan area fee programs into a single program covering the majority of the City. He provided oversight for the development of the \$450 million CIP associated with the program. In addition, Fritz directed traffic analysis efforts necessary for technical aspects of the nexus study, and provided analysis related to existing deficiencies and regional traffic in the nexus study.

Fritz performed similar roles for updates of the EGRFP occurring in 2004-05 and 2008-09.
