RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BOARD OF THE MOUNTAINS RECREATION AND CONSERVATION AUTHORITY SUPPORTING THE AMENDED CALIFORNIA CHILDREN'S OUTDOOR BILL OF RIGHTS

Resolved, That the Governing Board of the Mountains Recreation and Conservation Authority hereby:

1. FINDS that the California Roundtable on Recreation, Parks and Tourism, a volunteer consortium of public and private organizations has created the California Children's Outdoor Bill of Rights ; and
2. FINDS that the California Children's Outdoor Bill of Rights include and promote the experiences that are offered by the MRCA education and interpretive programs; and
3. FINDS that numerous studies document that children who participate in these outdoor recreation activities are healthier, do better in school, have better self image and social skills and lead more fulfilled lives; and
4. FINDS that participating in outdoor activities is not only enjoyable, but also develops an appreciation of California's unique environment; and
5. ADOPTS the staff report and recommendation dated April 4, 2012; and
6. AUTHORIZES the Executive Officer to do any and all acts necessary to carry out this resolution and any recommendations made by the Governing Board.
