On behalf of the City's Los Angeles River Project Office, which is tasked with implementing the City Council-adopted, long-range Los Angeles River Revitalization Master Plan (LARRMP), I am writing to recommend that the Mountains Recreation and Conservation Authority Board vote in favor of adopting the current plans for the proposed *Marsh Park Phase II Project*. This project is an expressed priority of the LARRMP as it is located in the Taylor Yard Opportunity Area (project no. 164, 10-31, LARRMP 2007) and included on the list of priority projects adopted by the City Council in 2008 (C.F. 07-1342-S2).

As you know, the LARRMP is a 20-to-50 year blueprint that recommends more than 240 projects along a 32-mile corridor of the river that is home to more than one million people. It aims to create at least 60 miles of publicly-accessible trails, parks, wildlife corridors, recreational facilities, and cultural amenities expected to result in lasting social and economic improvements, including improved public health and the attraction and retention of family-sustaining jobs. Implementation of the LARRMP involves close collaboration among a variety of public agencies, nonprofit organizations, private sector interests, and countless other groups and individuals. The Mountains Recreation and Conservation Authority has been an active, committed participant in this process and has successfully established itself as a champion of river-sensitive programs and projects; the first phase of *Marsh Park* is evidence of this.

Implementation of the *Marsh Park Phase II Project* can serve as a model for future river projects by simultaneously providing much-needed water quality, public access, wildlife habitat, and open space improvements—goals that are consistent with the LARRMP. In addition to expanding an existing park, the project will create safe public access to the Los Angeles River Bikeway and Juan Bautista de Anza National Historic Trail, accommodating pedestrians and bicyclists and raising awareness of the river's revitalization. The design has




been carefully and thoughtfully conceived and promotes a sustainable solution for stormwater runoff while providing wonderful opportunities for outdoor recreation, community gatherings, and environmental education programs.

While overseeing the implementation of the Los Angeles River Revitalization Master Plan, I have participated firsthand in the community based planning processes like the one that has taken place for Marsh Park. These efforts are helping to shape the landscape and the future of Los Angeles. I understand the critical role this particular park will play in establishing a greener, more sustainable presence along this stretch of the Los Angeles River and am grateful for the MRCA's leadership in making it possible.
