RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BOARD OF THE MOUNTAINS RECREATION AND CONSERVATION AUTHORITY (A) AUTHORIZING APPLICATION TO THE SANTA MONICA MOUNTAINS CONSERVANCY FOR A GRANT OF PROPOSITION 40 FUNDS FOR THE PURCHASE OF REMAINING INTEREST IN TOWSLEY CANYON PARCELS, AND (B) AUTHORIZING PURCHASE OF REMAINING INTEREST IN APN'S 2826-018-900 AND 066; -901 AND 067; -902 AND 068; 2826-019-901 AND 040, AND -902 AND 041.

Resolved, That the Governing Board of the Mountains Recreation and Conservation Authority hereby:

- 1. FINDS that the property interest in Towsley Canyon parcels as listed is ecologically and recreationally significant.
- 2. FINDS that the proposed action is categorically exempt from the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act.
- 3. ADOPTS the staff report and recommendation dated November 7, 2012.
- 4. AUTHORIZES purchase of the remaining one-quarter interest in .APN'S 2826-018-900 and 066; -901 and 067; -902 and 068; 2826-019-901 and 040, and -902 and 041; subject to conditions.
- 5. AUTHORIZES application to the Santa Monica Mountains Conservancy for a grant of Proposition 40 or other funds to acquire the property.
- 6. AUTHORIZES the Executive Officer to do any and all acts necessary to carry out this resolution and any recommendations made by the Governing Board.
