**RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BOARD OF THE MOUNTAINS RECREATION
AND CONSERVATION AUTHORITY AUTHORIZING SUBMISSION OF AN
APPLICATION TO THE SANTA MONICA MOUNTAINS CONSERVANCY
FOR A PROJECT PLANNING AND DESIGN GRANT FOR THE
UPSTREAM OF THE PACOIMA WASH RECREATIONAL
GREENWAY TO ANGELES NATIONAL FOREST WILL
PROVIDE SIGNIFICANT PUBLIC BENEFITS**

Resolved, That the Governing Board of the Mountains Recreation and Conservation Authority (MRCA) hereby:

1. FINDS that upstream of Pacoima Wash Recreational Greenway to Angeles National Forest will provide significant public benefits; and
2. FINDS that the proposed action is categorically exempt from the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act.
3. ADOPTS the staff report and recommendations dated May 1, 2013.
4. AUTHORIZES the submission of an application to the Santa Monica Mountains Conservancy for a project planning and design grant for the upstream of Pacoima Wash Recreational Greenway to Angeles National Forest.
5. AUTHORIZES the Executive Officer or his designee to do any and all acts necessary to carry out this resolution and any recommendations made by the Governing Board.
6. AUTHORIZES the Chair to sign the grant agreement if the grant application is approved by the Santa Monica Mountains Conservancy.
