**RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BOARD OF THE MOUNTAINS RECREATION  
AND CONSERVATION AUTHORITY AUTHORIZING SUBMISSION OF AN  
APPLICATION TO THE SANTA MONICA MOUNTAINS CONSERVANCY  
FOR A PROJECT PLANNING AND DESIGN GRANT FOR THE  
GRIFFITH PARK TO EL PUEBLO DE LOS ANGELES  
STATE HISTORIC PARK RECREATIONAL  
TRAIL CORRIDOR**

*Resolved*, That the Governing Board of the Mountains Recreation and Conservation Authority (MRCA) hereby:

1. FINDS that Griffith Park to El Pueblo de Los Angeles State Historic Park Recreational Trail Corridor will provide significant public benefits; and
2. FINDS that the proposed action is categorically exempt from the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act.
3. ADOPTS the staff report and recommendations dated May 1, 2013.
4. AUTHORIZES the application to the Santa Monica Mountains Conservancy for a project planning and design grant for the Griffith Park to El Pueblo de Los Angeles State Historic Park Recreational Trail Corridor.
5. AUTHORIZES the Executive Officer or his designee to do any and all acts necessary to carry out this resolution and any recommendations made by the Governing Board.
6. AUTHORIZES the Chair to sign the grant agreement if the grant application is approved by the Santa Monica Mountains Conservancy.
