- 2. FINDS that pursuant to the settlement agreement, the Santa Monica Mountains Conservancy and the MRCA are required to apply to the City of Malibu for a coastal development permit for certain park administrative uses;
- 3. FINDS that the proposed action is exempt from the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act;
- 4. ADOPTS the staff report and recommendation dated December 4, 2013;
- 5. AUTHORIZES the joint application with the Santa Monica Mountains Conservancy to the City of Malibu for a coastal development permit for park administrative uses, and
- 6. AUTHORIZES the Executive Officer to do any and all acts necessary to carry out this resolution and any recommendations made by the Governing Board.
