**RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BOARD OF THE MOUNTAINS RECREATION  
AND CONSERVATION AUTHORITY OPPOSING MEASURE F,  
CITY OF CALABASAS**

*Resolved*, That the Governing Board of the Mountains Recreation and Conservation Authority (MRCA) hereby:

1. FINDS that subject 77-acre Canyon Oaks property is too visually and ecologically sensitive for the level of development approved by the City of Calabasas City Council; and
2. FINDS that opposition to Measure F insures that a project with unavoidable significant adverse visual and ecological impacts will be overturned; and
3. FINDS that the proposed action is categorically exempt from the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA); and
4. ADOPTS the staff report and recommendation dated September 7, 2016; and
5. OPPOSES Measure F on the City of Calabasas November 8, 2016 ballot; and
6. AUTHORIZES the Executive Officer or his designee to do any and all acts necessary to carry out this resolution and any recommendations made by the Governing Board.
