## RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BOARD OF THE MOUNTAINS RECREATION AND CONSERVATION AUTHORITY AUTHORIZING ENTERING INTO A PROFESSIONAL SERVICES CONTRACT WITH THE LAS VIRGENES UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT FOR OUTDOOR EDUCATION CAMP AT KING GILLETTE RANCH, CALABASAS

*Resolved*, That the Governing Board of the Mountains Recreation and Conservation Authority (MRCA) hereby:

1. FINDS that residential outdoor education camp is in keeping with the priorities set by the joint agency planning committee for King Gillette Ranch; and
2. FINDS that the MRCA is uniquely suited to provide naturalist services and a residential camp experience for elementary school children; and
3. FINDS that the proposed action is categorically exempt from the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act; and
4. ADOPTS the staff report and recommendation dated December 7, 2016; and
5. AUTHORIZES execution of a contract with the Las Virgenes Unified School District for \$250 per student plus costs detailed in the scope of work; and
6. AUTHORIZES such budget amendments that may be necessary to implement these actions; and
7. AUTHORIZES the Executive Officer to do any and all acts necessary to carry out this resolution and any recommendations made by the Governing Board.
