RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BOARD OF THE MOUNTAINS RECREATION AND CONSERVATION AUTHORITY AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH PAN AMERICAN FOR FUEL MODIFICATION ON MRCA LAND AT BEVERLY GLEN SURPLUS/TOTTEN PROPERTY IN THE AMOUNT OF \$59,000 FOR THE PROTECTION AND RESTORATION OF NATURAL AND DEVELOPED RESOURCES BY REMOVAL OF INVASIVE PLANT SPECIES, REDUCTION OF HAZARDOUS FIRE-FUEL LOADS, AND EROSION PROTECTION

- 1. FINDS that fuel modification will provide significant public benefits.

- 6. AUTHORIZES the Executive Officer or his designee to do any and all acts necessary to carry out this resolution and any recommendations made by the Governing Board.
