Wilacre Park in Los Angeles is Open to the Public

LOS ANGELES – The Mountains Recreation and Conservation Authority announced today that Wilacre Park is open to the public. The park had been closed briefly for park improvements and renovation. Park operating hours are seven days a week, sunrise to sunset.

The Mountains Recreation and Conservation Authority (MRCA) is a local public park agency dedicated to the preservation and management of open space, urban parkland, watershed lands, trails, and wildlife habitat. The MRCA manages more than 72,000 acres of public parkland and provides natural resources and scientific expertise, critical regional planning services, operations, fire prevention and ranger services, as well as education and leadership programs for thousands of youth each year. It is one of the lead agencies revitalizing the Los Angeles River and its tributaries.
