



Garden of the Gods

Intersection of Santa Susana Pass Road and Topanga Canyon Boulevard, Chatsworth, California

The twenty three-acre Garden of the Gods park is perched in the northwest corner of the San Fernando Valley in Chatsworth. The park was once part of the historic Iverson Movie Ranch. The area was named for its massive sandstone rock formations.

Directions: Garden of the Gods is located in Chatsworth near the intersection of Santa Susana Pass Road and Topanga Canyon Boulevard. Red Mesa turns north off of Santa Susana Pass Road approximately 2,000 feet west of Topanga Canyon Boulevard. The 118/Topanga Canyon Blvd. interchange is less than one half mile from the site.
