

## Arroyo Seco - South Pasadena - Woodland and Wildlife Park

100 block of Pasadena Avenue, South Pasadena, California, 91030

The three-acre Woodland and Wildlife Park is located in the City of South Pasadena along the southern bank of the Arroyo Seco. The park features rarely-seen native California walnut trees and bio-swales that allow stormwater to infiltrate into the soil instead of flowing into the concrete-lined Arroyo Seco, adjacent to the park.

**Directions:** Exit 110-N at Avenue 64/Marmion Way. Stay to the right and follow Marmion Way/Arroyo Drive to Pasadena Avenue. Exit 110-S at York Boulevard. Turn left at the end of the off-ramp (Salonica Street) onto San Pascual Avenue. Turn left onto York Boulevard. Go over the bridge, where York Boulevard turns into Pasadena Avenue.


