



Tuna Canyon Park

Big Rock Drive, Malibu, California

The stunning Tuna Canyon property parallels more than two miles of the Pacific Ocean in Malibu and provides dramatic, 360-degree views from the San Gabriel mountains to the Santa Monica Bay. Deep canyons and ridges support a rich mosaic of coastal Southern California plant communities including sycamore riparian woodland, oak woodland, coastal sage scrub, and native grasslands.

Directions: From Pacific Coast Highway in Malibu, take Topanga Canyon Bl. 3.8 miles to Fernwood Pacific Dr. Turn left. Fernwood Pacific becomes Tuna Canyon Rd. Park entrance is at the intersection of Tuna Canyon Rd/Hearst Tank Mtwy.-Big Rock Motorway.
