RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BOARD OF THE MOUNTAINS RECREATION AND CONSERVATION AUTHORITY AUTHORIZING A GRANT APPLICATION TO THE SANTA MONICA MOUNTAINS CONSERVANCY FOR PROPOSITION 68 FUNDS FOR FRANKLIN CANYON PARK IMPROVEMENTS, BEVERLY HILLS.

Resolved, That the Governing Board of the Mountains Recreation and Conservation Authority (MRCA) hereby:

- 1. FINDS that Franklin Canyon Park improvements will provide significant public benefits;
- 2. FINDS that the proposed action is categorically exempt from the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act;
- 3. ADOPTS the staff report and recommendations dated August 8, 2018;
- 4. AUTHORIZES a grant application to the Santa Monica Mountains Conservancy for Proposition 68 funds for Franklin Canyon Park improvements, Beverly Hills, in an amount not to exceed \$300,000;
- 5. AUTHORIZES any budget amendments as necessary;
- 6. AUTHORIZES the Executive Officer or his designee to do any and all acts necessary to carry out this resolution and any recommendations made by the Governing Board; and
- 7. AUTHORIZES the Chair to sign the grant agreement if the grant application is approved by the Santa Monica Mountains Conservancy.
