RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BOARD OF THE MOUNTAINS RECREATION AND CONSERVATION AUTHORITY AUTHORIZING A PROPOSITION 68 GRANT APPLICATION TO THE SANTA MONICA MOUNTAINS CONSERVANCY FOR THE ACQUISITION OF PHASE 4 OF THE TRIANGLE RANCH PROJECT (PORTIONS OF APNS 2063-005-013 and 2063-006-0220, MEDEA CREEK, UNINCORPORATED LOS ANGELES COUNTY

Resolved, That the Governing Board of the Mountains Recreation and Conservation Authority (MRCA) hereby:

- 1. FINDS that a portion of the Triangle Ranch property is significant to the Malibu Creek watershed and Liberty Canyon wildlife corridor distribution lands;
- 2. FINDS that the proposed actions are categorically exempt from the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA);
- 3. ADOPTS the staff report and recommendation dated November 7, 2018; and
- 4. AUTHORIZES submission of a grant application to the Santa Monica Mountains Conservancy for Proposition 68 funds to acquire the remaining approximately 150 portion of the Triangle Ranch property in the Medea Creek watershed;
- 5. AUTHORIZES any budget amendments as necessary;
- 6. AUTHORIZES the Executive Officer or his designee to do any and all acts necessary to carry out this resolution and any recommendations made by the Governing Board; and
- 7. AUTHORIZES the Chairperson to sign the grant agreement if the grant application is approved by the Santa Monica Mountains Conservancy.
