Mountains Recreation and Conservation Authority Issues List of Park Closures

CALABASAS, CA (November 14, 2018) — The Mountains Recreation and Conservation Authority (MRCA) announced today that the following parks managed by the MRCA are closed to the public due to circumstances related to the recent Hill and Woosley fire incidents:
