**RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BOARD OF THE MOUNTAINS RECREATION  
AND CONSERVATION AUTHORITY AUTHORIZING SIGNING A LETTER OF  
INTENT WITH RELEVANT PUBLIC AGENCIES TO DEVELOP A LOS  
ANGELES RIVER PARK PARTNERSHIP THAT UNIFIES  
PLANNING EFFORTS THROUGHOUT THE 100 ACRES  
OF PUBLIC OPEN SPACE AT TAYLOR YARD,  
CITY OF LOS ANGELES**

*Resolved*, That the Governing Board of the Mountains Recreation and Conservation Authority (MRCA) hereby:

1. FINDS that the proposed action is categorically exempt from the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act;
2. FINDS that development of a Los Angeles River Park Partnership amongst relevant public agencies will foster a collaborative and efficient approach to planning and development of public open space at Taylor Yard and will provide significant public benefits;
3. ADOPTS the staff report and recommendations dated October 2, 2019;
4. AUTHORIZES the Executive Officer, or designee, to sign the Letter of Intent with relevant public agencies to develop a Los Angeles River Park Partnership for the purpose of unifying planning efforts throughout the 100 acres of public open space at Taylor Yard;
5. FURTHER AUTHORIZES the Executive Officer or his designee to do any and all acts necessary to carry out this resolution and any recommendations made by the Governing Board; and
