RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BOARD OF THE MOUNTAINS RECREATION AND CONSERVATION AUTHORITY AUTHORIZING ENTERING INTO A GRANT AGREEMENT WITH THE WILDLIFE CONSERVATION BOARD FOR THE ACQUISITION OF APPROXIMATELY 320 ACRES (APNS 1033-151-27 AND 1033-171-14) AND AUTHORIZING ACQUISITION OF SAID PARCELS, ADJACENT TO CHINO HILLS STATE PARK, CITY OF CHINO HILLS

Resolved, That the Governing Board of the Mountains Recreation and Conservation Authority (MRCA) hereby:

- 1. FINDS that the approximately 320 acres composed of APNs 1033-151-27 and 1033-171-14 in the Chino Hills will provide significant public and ecological benefits; and
- 2. FINDS that the proposed actions are categorically exempt from the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act; and
- 3. FINDS that the subject 320 acres are high priority acquisitions for the State Park system; and
- 4. ADOPTS the staff report and recommendation dated December 4, 2019; and
- 5. AUTHORIZES the fee simple acquisition of approximately 320 acres (APNs 1033-151-27 and 1033-171-14) in the Chino Hills;
- 6. AUTHORIZES entering into a grant agreement with the Wildlife Conservation Board; and
- 7. AUTHORIZES any budget amendments as necessary; and
- 8. AUTHORIZES the Executive Officer or his designee to do any and all acts necessary to carry out this resolution and any recommendations made by the Governing Board.
