The Woolsey Fire destroyed the Shalom Institute and Conference Center in the Santa Monica Mountains in 2018. In cooperation with the State and the California Natural Resources Agency (CNRA), MRCA is assisting to distribute State funds to rebuild the camp and conference center to the Shalom Institute. Prior to the Woolsey Fire, the Shalom Institute, a 120 acre resident camp, community center, and retreat center campus, located at 34342 Mulholland Hwy, Malibu, Ca. 90265 included in part the following structures, program areas, and infrastructure:

The focus of the rebuild will be on sustainability (net zero), universal design, flexibility for all modes of operation, security, and fire mitigation.


The estimated cost to rebuild is \$30 million.


